

Name giving of the 'MAERSK VIRTUE' in Korea.

On Wednesday 22nd August 2007, A.P. Moller Singapore Pte Ltd latest new building, a 82.000 cbm VLGC gas tanker built in Korea was named. The sponsor Mrs. Haruyo Ishiguro, wife of Mr. Toshio Ishiguro, Chairman of Astomos Energy Corporation honoured the owner, A.P. Moller Singapore Pte Ltd., by naming the newbuilding MAERSK VIRTUE at Hyundai Heavy Industries Co. Ltd. in Ulsan, Korea.
