

DELIVERY OF MAERSK NUCLEUS

On the 27th of October, 2007, A.P. Moller Singapore Pte., Ltd latest new building, a 307,284 MT VLCC (Hull number T3000-11) Maersk Nucleus (a N Class VLCC) was named and delivered by Dalian Shipbuilding Industries Corp. (DSIC) in China.

Maersk Nucleus, is the fourth in her class of ships delivered to A.P. Moller Singapore. The vessel is fitted with latest state of the art Sulzer 7RT-Flex 84T-D engine and delivers 29,400 KW power at 78 RPM taking the vessel to speeds higher that 16.5 Knots at 85% MCR.

Maersk Nucleus is registered in Singapore and commanded by Capt. Pankaj Mohan with Chief Engineer Surjit Mohan Arur as Chief engineer on her maiden voyage.
