

DELIVERY OF MAERSK TAIKUNG

On 15th November 2007, M.V. Maersk Taikung (New building Hull No. 4118) built at Daewoo Shipbuilding & Marine Engineering Co. Ltd, Korea was delivered.

The 94,193 T, 8,100 TEU Container Vessel is the second in the series of T-Type vessels delivered to A.P. Moller Singapore. The vessel is fitted with a DOOSAN SULZER 12RT-FLEX96C engine delivering 68,640 KW taking the vessel on speeds upto 24.8 Knots.

Maersk Taikung is about 320 m long with a beam of 43.2 m and a depth of 20.23 meters.

Maersk Taikung will be registered in Singapore and commanded by Captain Yogamber Singh Bisht, with Mr. Kishore Babu Yanamandra as Chief Engineer on her maiden voyage.
