

## Delivery of the 'LPG/C MAERSK VENTURE'



On Friday, 4<sup>th</sup> January 2008, A.P. Moller Singapore Pte Ltd latest new building, MAERSK VENTURE, an 82,000 cbm VLGC gas tanker built in Korea was delivered.

MAERSK VENTURE is the last in a series of four Very Large Gas Carrier (VLGC) from Hyundai Samho Heavy Industries Co. Ltd. and is part of a significant expansion for the A.P. Moller - Maersk Group in LPG transportation segment. The vessel is fitted with a Hyundai B&W 6S60ME-C engine delivering 13,560KW of power and taking the vessels upto a speed of 17.7 knots.

MAERSK VENTURE is registered in Singapore and will be commanded by Captain Anoop Rana, with Mr. Ajay Shankar Shukla as Chief Engineer on her maiden voyage
