

DELIVERY OF MAERSK BINTAN

On 27 February 2008, M.V. Maersk Bintan (New Building Hull No. N-186) built at Hanjin Heavy Industries & Construction Co. Ltd, Korea was delivered.

The 35,849.6 GRT, 3,000 TEU Container Vessel is the first in the series of B-Type container vessels delivered to A.P. Moller Singapore. The vessel is fitted with a HYUNDAI-MAN B&W 8K80 ME-C engine delivering 28,200 KW taking the vessel speed up to 22.1 Knots.

Maersk Bintan is about 212.2 meters long with a beam of 32.2 meters and a depth of 16.56 meters.

Maersk Bintan is registered in Singapore and commanded by Capt. Atul Bajjal, with Mr. Mohandass Govindarajalu as Chief Engineer on her maiden voyage.
