

Delivery of Maersk Nautica

On 3 April 2008, A.P. Moller Singapore's latest new building (Hull No. T3000-13) was named Maersk Nautica and delivered by Dalian Shipbuilding Industries Corporation in China.

The 307,284 DWT vessel is the sixth in the series of N-Class vessels delivered to A.P. Moller Singapore. She is fitted with Sulzer 7RT Flex 84T-D engine and renders 29,400 KW at 76 RPM Engine taking the vessel speeds up to 16.1 Knots at 85% MCR. Maersk Nautica is about 321 metres long with a beam of 51 metres and dept of 31 metres.

Maersk Nautica is registered in Singapore and commanded by Captain Jasbir Singh Mundy with Mr. Foo Kwong Juan as Chief Engineer on her Maiden Voyage.
