

Delivery of Maersk Algol

On 25th March 2008, A.P. Moller Singapore Pte Ltd latest new building, a 9,000 TEU Container vessel built in Korea was named.

The sponsor Ms. Sys Rovsing wife of Mr. Hans Skov Christensen, Director of the Danish Industry, honoured the owner, A.P. Moller Singapore Pte Ltd., by naming the new building MAERSK ALGOL at Samsung Heavy Industries Co. Ltd. in Ulsan, Korea.

Mr. Søren Skou, Partner, A.P. Moller – Maersk Group Executive board & CEO, Maersk Tankers hosted the name giving ceremony, which was attended by representatives from the maritime industry and employees from the A.P. Moller – Maersk Group.

The 107,700 DWT container vessel is the fourth in the series of the A-Type containers vessels for delivery to A.P. Moller Singapore. Similar to its sister vessels, Maersk Antares, Maersk Alfirk and Maersk Altair, MAERSK ALGOL is about 323 meters long with a beam of 45.6 meters and a depth of 22.81 metres. The vessel is fitted with a WARTSILA NSD 12RT-FLEX96C engine delivering 68,640 KW and taking the vessel to speeds upto 25.5 knots

MAERSK ALGOL is registered in Singapore and will be commanded by Captain Min Swe, with Mr. God Thian Eng as Chief Engineer.
