

Delivery of Maersk Bali

On 29 August 2008, A.P. Moller Singapore's latest new building M.V. Maersk Bali (New Building Hull No. N-195) built at Hanjin Heavy Industries and Construction Co. Ltd, South Korea was delivered.

The 35,835 GRT, 3,100 TEU Container Vessel is the fourth in the series of B-Type container vessels delivered to A.P. Moller Singapore.

The vessel is fitted with a HYUNDAI MAN B&W 8K80 ME-C engine delivering 28,800KW taking the vessel speed up to 22.1 Knots. Maersk Bali is about 212.2 meters long with a beam of 32.2 meters and a depth of 16.56 meters.

Maersk Bali is registered under the Singapore flag and commanded by Captain Anant Kumar Bansal, with Mr. Lui Vyas as Chief Engineer on her maiden voyage.
